The boards which support this feature are identified with a "Configurable" label in the Gameboard and Progress Board list views. While the standard set of boards may not be altered, a "Create Copy" option allows administrators to create a customized clone of their desired board which may then be modified with the designer tool.	8.2

By default this period is 180 days, but this can be changed via the "Audit Trail Retention Period" customer configuration. Archived audit trail entries are stored in a new table accessible to OnPoint personnel should reporting be required.	8.2

These logins can be configured to include the users' names, initials, OPLS IDs, email addresses, and/or last 4 digits of their phone numbers. Login IDs may still be entered as normal, but if the "Generate on Save" checkbox is selected for a new user an appropriate login ID will be generated upon user creation. The same process can be incorporated into user imports to automatically generate login IDs for imported users. This does not apply to customers utilizing SSO for access.	8.2

When a proxy is established, the "proxying" manager gains temporary management rights over the groups, job codes, org units managed by the "proxied" manager until the proxy is ended. Both managers can continue to access OPMM in the same manner, the only difference being that the "proxying" manager now also sees the members of the temporarily managed groups, job codes, and org units as well as their normal users. To facilitate this feature, a new dropdown option has been added in OPCM under which administrators can create new proxies, view/end existing proxies, and review past proxies. Only administrators may create/end proxies; managers may not do this themselves.	8.2

This distinction and the associated filters allow administrators to more easily locate their desired badges for objects and games without having to look through the full list of available badges each time. This only affects OPLS-created and managed badges; integrations with systems such as Badgr are not included in this functionality.	8.2
