## **Section 1: Overview**

This document will outline the steps needed to edit an HTML document within a test environment. The team can access this slice and menu using any existing Root Admin account. If you need a specific admin for this slice, that can be created as well.

## **Steps for Editing**

- 1. After logging and selecting the document Manager from the Opportal, you will choose the menu item labeled "Company Info".
- 2. Once this main menu item is selected choose the "Test" sub-menu item

4. Once you have selected "Test" you will see the image that is below. There is the word "edit" under the Launch column located next to the Icon. This is highlighted in Yellow in the image. This edit link is only available to admins that are allowed to edit this document.


